The small print:

- This track night is open to members of Monklands Sporting Car Club and invited guests.
- Entry fee for the evening is £70 on the night. Please enclose a cheque made payable to "Monklands Sporting Car Club Ltd." with your registration.
- Refunds will only apply for cancellations made two days before the event.
- Sign on is from 5pm with a short driver briefing at 5.45pm which all drivers must attend.
- Drivers arriving after this time will require a one to one briefing before being allowed on track.
- The track will be open from 6pm until 8pm.
- A maximum of 40 cars will be admitted to the track night.
- Registration is on a first come first served basis. MSCC members will be given preference should the night be over-subscribed. Payment is in advance by cheque payable to MSCC Ltd.
- The track night is for any closed wheel saloon or sports car. If you are unsure if your car will be allowed on track please contact Knockhill Racing Circuit on 01383 723337.
- This track night is operated by Knockhill Racing Circuit, admittance to the track is at their discretion.
- Cars are subject to Knockhill roadworthiness standards, drivers must complete a self scrutineering form.
- **All cars must be fitted with seatbelts, without exception.**
- All drivers must hold a full driving licence.
- Drivers must heed the Knockhill track night rules for driving standards, as explained at the driver briefing.
- Driving standards will be observed by Knockhill staff and drivers not obeying these rules will be black flagged at which point they must return to pit lane at the end of their next lap for further briefing.
- **Knockhill operate a "three strikes and you're out" rule.** Any driver who is black flagged three times will be not be allowed to continue and may not be allowed to return to an MSCC track night.
- Any car with obvious mechanical issues will be black flagged and the driver asked to rectify the issue before being allowed to continue.
- Helmets are mandatory for all drivers and passengers whilst on track. These are available to hire from Knockhill on the night.
- Any passengers must sign and will receive a passenger wrist band. Only one passenger may ride in any car and must be carried in the front passenger's seat. It is the driver's responsibility to ensure any passenger in their car is signed on.
- In car cameras are only permitted where they are securely fixed to the car. Handheld and mobile phone cameras may not be used on track.
- Most importantly, you agree to adhere to all track night rules when you sign on!
