1. I have been given an opportunity to read the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association and, if any, the Supplementary Regulations for this event and agree to be bound by them. I declare that I am physically and mentally fit to take part in the event and I am competent to do so. I acknowledge that I understand the nature and type of the event and the potential risk inherent with motor sport and agree to accept that risk.
 2. To the best of my belief the driver(s) possess(es) the standard of competence necessary for an event of the type to which this entry relates and that the vehicle entered is suitable and roadworthy for the event having regard to the course and the speeds which will be reached.
 3. The use of the vehicle hereby entered is covered by insurance as required by the law which is valid for such part of this event as shall take place on roads as defined by the law.
 4. I understand that should I at any time of this event be suffering from any disability whether permanent or temporary which is likely to affect prejudicially my normal control of the vehicle, I may not take part unless I have declared such disability to the ASN which has, following such declaration, issued a licence which permits me to do so.
 5. Any application form for a Licence which was signed by a person under the age of 18 years was countersigned by that person's parent/legal guardian/guardantor, whose full names and addresses have been given.
 6. If I am the Parent/Guardian/Guardantor of the driver I understand that I shall have the right to be present during any procedure being carried out under the Supplementary Regulations issued for this event and the General Regulations of the MSA. As the Parent/Guardian/Guardantor I confirm that I have acquainted myself with the MSA General Regulations, agree to pay any appropriate charges and fees pursuant to those Regulations (to include any appendices thereto) and hereby agree to be bound by those Regulations and submit myself without reserve to the consequences resulting from those Regulations (and any subsequent alteration thereof). Further, I agree to pay as liquidated damages any fines imposed upon me up to the maxima set out in Part 3, Appendix 3.

2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the MSA, incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA. These supplementary regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue.

4. The event is open to all fully elected members of: Monklands Sporting Car Club, Morgan Car Club
5. All competitors must produce a valid club membership card.
6. The programme of the meeting will be as follows;
Scrutineering starts: 10.30am
First runs: 11.00am
7. The event is held entirely on private property on a grass surface. All vehicles must comply with the MSA technical regulations C(b) and D except:
C(b).15 Mud and Snow or 'Off Road' tyres will not be allowed.
D14 Pylons may be less than 1.0m in height.
D69 Vehicles need not be taxed.
8. The event will consist of four classes as follows:
1. Front wheel drive saloon cars
2. Rear wheel drive saloon cars
3. Sports cars.
4. Specials of any description, including LSD cars.
9. The event is a round of the Monklands Sporting Car Club Championship. Awards will be presented as follows:
First overall First Lady (If 3 or more compete)
First in each class. (subject to 4 or more entries in class / category)
Results will be based on index of performance.

d. The start signal will be by marshals countdown or flag.

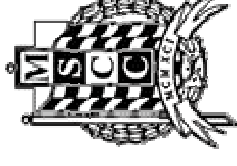
e. The order of attempting tests will be by competition number except if previously agreed with the Clerk of the course.
