

FORRESTBURN AUTOTEST/SOLO/PCA SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS 2022

- 1. Monklands Sporting Car Club Ltd (MSCC) will promote two RS Clubman permit Autotest, and Production Car Autotest (PCA) Meetings at Forrestburn near Kirk o' Shotts Postcode ML7 4NW; OS Map 65/861649; GPS 55.864260, -3.821105. The dates are May 15th and July 24th 2022.
- 2. The meetings will be governed by the general regulations of MOTORSPORT UK (incorporating the International Sporting Code of the FIA); these supplementary regulations; and any written instructions that Monkland Sporting Car Club Ltd (the organizer) may issue for the events.
- 3. MOTORSPORT UK permit numbers are:
 - o 124577 for Autotest May 15th
 - o 125478 for PCA May 15th
 - o 124578 for Autotest July 24th
 - o 125481 for PCA July 24th
- 4. The The event is open to all fully elected members of: Monklands Sporting Car Club, and invitation extended to members of Scottish Sporting Car Club
- 5. All competitors must produce a valid Club Membership Card and a competition license to minimum MUK RS Clubmans Licence.
- 6. The programme for the day will be:

Gates open 10.00am for signing on Driver Briefing 10.45am
First runs 11.00am.

There will be a break for lunch in the paddock with competition concluding around 15.30pm

- 7. The competition will take place in the paddock and part of the hillclimb track, on an all-tarmac surface
- 8. The following class structure will apply. *Please note that the organisers retain the right to re-allocate vehicles to classes on the day depending upon the field of entries.

1	Autotest – Front wheel drive saloon and sports cars. No passengers
2	Autotest – Rear wheel drive saloon and sports cars. No passengers
3	Autotest – Specials*. No passengers
4	Production Car Autotest. Production cars only, front or rear wheel drive,
	and carrying ONE passenger. Drivers over 14 allowed

9. The entry list opens on publishing of these regulations on the MSCC website. Entries are accepted up to 48 hours before the event.

- Online entry and payment will be available on the Monklands Sporting Car Club website at https://www.mscc.org.uk where Supplementary Regulations will also be published. The entry fee is £30 per event including a BBQ lunch.
- 11. For Entries into classes 1-3 NO PASSENGERS ARE ALLOWED. For class 4 (PCA) ONE PASSENGER MUST BE CARRIED in the front passenger seat. No other passengers are allowed. For PCA class 4, the SAME passenger must be carried throughout the event.
- 12. If the entrant is under 16 they must be accompanied by a passenger who carries a full DVLA driving licence, and they must enter the Production Car Autotest (class 4)
- 13. Properly approved seatbelts must be worn at all times during tests, but helmets are not required.
- 14. All vehicles must comply with Motorsport UK Yearbook Technical Regulations M4 and M19.
- 15. No postal entries are accepted. If for any reason an on-line entry cannot be made, please contact the competition secretary Sarah Shephard by email sarah@mscc.org.uk
- 16. Entries will be acknowledged by email. If an event is cancelled, entry fees will be returned to entrants.
- 17. A refund in full will be made to any entrant who withdraws before the closing date of the meeting, after which £5 will be deducted for administration. Any entrant failing to notify the Secretary of the Meeting of non-appearance will NOT be entitled to any refund.
- 18. The maximum entry for the meeting is 30. The minimum is 15. The minimum for each class is 3. Should any of these minimum figures not be reached, the organizers reserve the right to cancel the meeting, or to amalgamate classes as they judge appropriate.
- 19. Each car may be entered by a maximum of TWO drivers.
- 20. The course details will be made available to drivers on the day. There will be no practice runs.
- 21. Timing will be by stopwatch, starting signal verbal. Results will be available on line after the event.
- 22. Prizes will be given for 1st and 2nd placing in each class subject to number of entries.
- 23. The event will be run according to section M of the Motorsport UK Yearbook. Protests must be lodged in accordance with section C5 of same.
- 24. The officials of the meeting will be listed on the day.
