1. **DIRECTIONS:** From M8, exit Junction 5, turn right along B7066 for 0.9 miles, turn 1st right (Dewshill). Follow road for 1 mile. From A89 turn south at Forrestfield, follow the road for 1.5 miles.
2. **DRIVING TO/FROM LOCATION;** We would appreciate if everyone driving to the track would please drive slowly along Forrest Road as some of the road surface is very uneven.
3. **ACCESS – GATES OPEN** at noon Friday and Sunday. Gates will be closed at 9pm each night each day. If you would like to arrive on Friday night or anticipate arrival outside these times, please phone David Reid: Competition Secretary on 07736 666485 for access.

5. **PARKING:** The car park is to the left at the entrance. All cars / vans / towing vehicles and trailers must be parked here and not left in the paddock. The only exception is for classes C1-C5 who will be sited on the usual designated area in the paddock.
6. **UNLOADING / LOADING cars on trailers must unload in the paddock before 8.30am. No trailers will allowed into the paddock after that time. No car may be loaded in the paddock before the**

end of the meeting. Any competitor violating this instruction will be excluded from the results.

7. **PADDOCK** layout. There are designated places for each competitor indicated in the diagram below. Please adhere to directions given and have consideration to others requiring access when loading and unloading. THERE IS A STRICT SPEED LIMIT OF 10mph WITHIN THE PADDOCK AND ALL ACCESS ROADS.

8. **ADMINISTRATION:**

Driver Sign On from	08.00 hrs (Note you will be required to show your licence)
Driver Briefing	08.45 hrs
Scrutineering	from 08.30 hrs
First run	09.30 hrs

9. **OVERALLS AND CRASH HELMETS:** Monklands Sporting Car Club reminds competitors of the MOTORSPORT UK regulations K9 and K10 regarding the wearing of clean fire-resistant overalls and crash helmets. If a sticker is needed, please contact one of the scrutineers on site, or speak to a MSCC official.

10. **COMPETITION NUMBERS:** Numbers will be available at a cost of £1 each from the Competition Secretary. Please have exact change.

11. **SIGNING OF LICENCES:** Any competitor wishing to have their licence signed please speak with the Clerk of the Course **prior** to starting the event.

12. **WALKING ON THE HILL:** ALL Competitors are required walk the hill prior to practice.

13. **RED FLAG:** If during a run you are shown a red flag, the following procedure must be adopted. Slow down to walking speed as quickly as it is safe to do so and stop at the next marshal post. Do not move until given verbal instructions from the marshals at that post. The marshals will confirm that you understand their instructions, which must always be complied with.

14. **CAR OFF THE TRACK** – If your car leaves the track, please signal to the marshals that you are OK by showing a **thumbs up**. Marshals have been instructed to touch cars *only if absolutely necessary* so if you can self-recover, please do so. the track. More information is available for this on request.

15. **NOISE** - The MOTORSPORT UK limit is 110db for single seat racing cars 108db for all other classes. All cars must have exhaust silencers fitted (unless period defined)

16. **METHANOL** – Cars using methanol must indicate that they are doing so and use an additive such that the flame is coloured

17. **AWARDS:** Class awards will be given for every class and 2nd place awarded if more than five entries in class. Divisional winners will be awarded as per Supplementary Regulations

General

18. **OVERNIGHT CAMPING:** Camping is available for the Friday and Saturday nights should

competitors wish to stay. The designated camping area is the lower car park (Classes C1-5 camping with trailers on grass area by the paddock.)

19. **DOGS:** No dogs are permitted in the paddock or on the hill whether they are on a lead or not.
20. **REFRESHMENTS:** Refreshments will be available in the paddock. Please bring cash if the card reader is not working due to signal.
21. **WASTE OIL DISPOSAL:** Competitors should note that all waste oil should be disposed of in the drum provided in the paddock.
22. **RUBBISH.** All rubbish must be taken home with you. MSCC are not able to dispose of it for you.
23. **DRONES** are prohibited anywhere on site
